6-12 month tasks

Task 7.1 National Awareness meetings

•Prepare the ground for the meetings:

- •Sending info on MedGOOS and MAMA to a wide audience
- •Preparing national Med GOOs websites and promoting the event
- Consultation with key national stakeholders
- •Establish organising committees with key stakeholders as members to promote "ownership" of the event

•Finalize the preparation of the NAM guidelines and all the conference pack documents

•Establish time schedule of the meetings





6-12 month tasks (cont.) Task 7.2 General Awareness

- By the end of July 2002, to receive contributions from all participants on the **planned national awareness activities** for the duration of the project
- •Workpackage leader to carry out **further awareness raising** activities:
- An article on GOOS, MED GOOS and the MAMA project.
- •Providing regular information on the progress of the project, through the MAMA website and possibly in a special section of "MEDWAVES" dedicated to Med GOOS.
- Providing information on the MAMA national awareness meetings through the MAMA website and "MEDWAVES", including a calendar of the meetings when this becomes available and due notice of the schedule and venue of each individual meeting as it approaches.





6-12 month achievements

Task 7.1 National Awareness Meetings

- 1. The Guidelines for the Meetings are ready and have been posted on the MAMA website.
- 2. A 2nd information letter (to promote the NAM) has been prepared and sent to:
- National MED POL Coordinators in 20 Mediterranean countries
- A number of other relevant ministerial representatives in the Med countries
- 23 selected Mediterranean Institutes
- Posted on the MAMA website for distribution by the national responsible partners in each country.
- 3. Croatia and Cyprus have prepared their MAMA websites to promote the NAM





6-12 month achievements

Task 7.2 General Awareness

- Reports received on the planned awareness activities (for the duration of the project) from Albania, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Croatia, Cyprus, Lebanon, Yugoslavia. These have been posted on the MAMA website.
- •Article on the MAMA project in "MEDWAVES", the MAP quarterly, with a distribution throughout the Mediterranean and beyond, published in English, French and Arabic.
- Work on the preparation of the Workpackage 7 "page" for the MAMA website.





12-18 month tasks ahead

Task 7.1 National Awareness meetings Until the end of 2002:

National responsible partners :

- Carry out further consultations with key national stakeholders
- Establish and report the members of national organising committees
- Establish and report time schedules of the meetings
- National reports on MAMA/MEDGOOS and related national activities (by MAMA National Responsible Partners) for conference pack material.

Workpackage 7 leader and MAMA Secretariat:

- 1. Finalize the preparation of all the conference pack documents
- Written contributions from MAMA Coordinator, MAMA Secretariat and MAMA Advisory Board

National responsible partners :

- Conduction of National Awareness Meetings scheduled for months 13-18
- Continue promotion of NAM scheduled for months 18-27

Workpackage 7 leader and MAMA Secretariat:

- 1. Follow-up and assistance for the smooth conduction of the National Awareness meetings:
- Close cooperation with organising committees
- Ensure availability of experts from the MAMA consortium
- Ensure timely availability of conference pack documents and other material
